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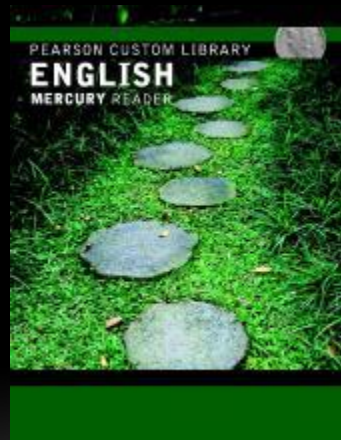
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CO-REQUISITE PAIRING

- Success (C or higher):
56.3%
- Retention (D or higher):
62.3%

- Success (C or higher):
66%

Data for 94 students

THE MODEL

VSCC 1000

- 28 students, 18 of whom are also in READ 0810
- 2 “sections” per VSCC 1000 class
 - VSCC 1000 002 (10)
 - VSCC 1000 X02 (18)

READ 0810

- 18 students per class
- same books
- online programs
- early exit

°Collaboration between instructors°

FALL 2015: THE NUMBERS

- Thirty (30!) co-req pairs on two campuses and a total of 30 instructors.
 - Seventeen are new faculty.
 - Nine had never taught college before this semester.
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DO

- Hire early
 - Get instructors processed through HR with enough time for them to learn
 - your LMS
 - college website
 - the online materials

DO

- Train early
 - The more people who attend an intensive training (half-day), the fewer challenges during the semester
 - Create master online course; create online faculty forum
 - Create a manual
 - Faculty binder
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DO

- Have FT faculty available
 - Hands-on help
 - Observation and evaluation of new instructors
 - Become close friends with your publisher's rep/tech person
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DO

- Schedule optional faculty meetings during the semester; offer free food
 - Keep detailed notes
 - New items to include in binder
 - Common questions and problems
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DON'T

Hire late

UNFOUNDED FEARS

- Faculty buy in
- Room allocation
- Staffing
 - VSCC adjunct pay: \$500 – 650/credit hour
 - Qualifications
 - READ 0810
 - VSCC 1000
